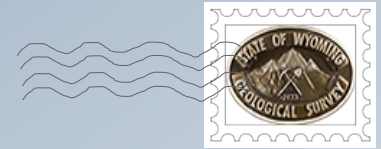

- *Located on the Continental Divide in the Precambrian core of the Wind River Mountains*
- *View is north-northwest from the top of Fremont Peak*
