Mr. Jim McGucken is a lawyer interested in this. Took out two carloads of Mn oxides ore which averaged 40 and 44% Mn. The ore occurs as veins in an altered porphyry. Several small veins which vary in width can be seen in a tunnel. The tunnel is about 40' long from which is a drift about 10 ft. long connecting with another short tunnel to the W. A pit about 15-20' deep contains some good ore.

Small. Insufficient development work.

Can see little on surface. Require more work and mapping.

Visited with Peterson and oldest son.
